Samuel Louis Williams, 57, of Perryville, passed away Sunday, December 2, 2007. He was born June 25, 1950 in Little Rock, Arkansas, a son of the late Frank Henry Williams and Exa Mae Hyatt Williams. He served in the U.S. Army from 1970-1972, attending boot camp at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. He had an F.B.I. class II Crypto NATO USAER Your Eyes Only Data. He was the only enlisted man to have such a high level of clearance.

Mr. Williams became a journeyman electrician and specialized in electrical work throughout his career. Sam was very handy and accomplished in several trade disciplines.

In 1999 he was a founding firefighter for Williams Junction Volunteer Fire Department. In 2005, he was a Basic Fire Fighter, Medical First Responder, and Haz-mat First Responder. He received the "Outstanding Fireman Award" in the community of Williams Junction, Arkansas.

He is survived by his brother, Steve and wife Lynn Williams of Grape Vine, Texas; nephew, Dustin Williams and wife Karen of Fort Worth, Texas; sister-in-law, Teresa Williams of Greenwood, Arkansas; Many cousins and dear friends also survive.
