Sherrye Woodward Shipp, age 83, of Morrilton passed away on Monday August 29th, 2022. She was born July 17th, 1939 in Humphrey, Arkansas, a daughter of the late Charles Elis Woodward and the late Amber Starr Woodward. She was the widow of Benny Max Shipp. Sherrye was a faithful member of the Downtown Church of Christ for 63 years. She was also a member of Delta Kappa Gamma, Conway County Retired Teachers, and Arkansas Retired Teachers Association.

Sherrye attended Arkansas Tech University while raising a family. After graduating, she began her teaching career at Morrilton Kindergarten in 1976 and later earned her Masters and Specialist Degrees at UCA. She served as Principal at the SCCSD Middle School at Menifee. She was then promoted to Instructional Supervisor for the South Conway County School District. Sherrye loved attending all Morrilton Devil Dog Athletic events, Band and Choir programs, and Drama performances. She was also an avid Razorback fan.
