Thomas Harold Baskins, age 91, of Morrilton, Arkansas, passed away Monday, February 22, 2016. He was born April 1, 1924 in Morrilton, Arkansas, a son of Jess Baskins and Ora Kissire Baskins. He grew up in Center Ridge, Arkansas, with his parents and sister. Following high school, he joined the Coast Guard and served during World War II.
