Virgil "Chic" Williams, Jr., 84, of Perryville, left this life November 27, 2013. He was born December 5, 1928 in Naylor, Arkansas. Preceded in death are his parents Virgie Arnett Williams and Virgil Williams, Sr. and a brother Bobby (Cotton) Williams. Survivors include his wife of 60 years, Peggy Bennett Williams; daughter, Donna Kincaid; son, Billy G.
