Warren Eugene Brewer, age 86, of Morrilton, formerly of Russellville, Arkansas, passed away Thursday, July 26, 2007. He was born February 4, 1921, in Enid, Oklahoma, a son of Ira Brewer and Nell "Rounds Brewer. Mr. Brewer was retired from the United States Air Force after twenty-eight years of service as a Chief Master Sergeant, when he was 45 years old. While in the military he served during World War II, and the Korean Conflict. He was stationed in Cairo Egypt for 4 ½ years and the Canal Zone, Panama for 4 ½ years, and was very fortunate to have his family with him during these times. He was of the Christian faith.

Survivors include his wife of 64 years, Patricia Wheeler Brewer of Morrilton; three sons, Wade Eugene Brewer of Norco, California, James Warren Brewer of Atwater, California, and Ronald Vern Brewer of El Paso, Texas; two daughters, Patricia Ann McCandless of Upland, California, and Pamela Sue Baker of Morrilton; eleven grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.
