February 22, 1918 - November 23, 2007

Rev. William "Bill" T. Curtin, 89, retired Boeing Cost Estimator, and Assembly of God Minister, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, November 23, 2007 in Morrilton, Arkansas. He was born February 22, 1918 in Emporia, Kansas, to the late William A. and Catherine Dell (O'Connell) Curtin.

He graduated from Winfield High School and in 1942 entered the Army Air Corp., serving his country during WWII. In 2006 he was honored for 50 years as an ordained minister with the Assemblies of God. On November 24, 1940 he married Betty L. Collins in Hardtner, Kansas, two children were born to this union. Betty preceded him in death on October 9, 1990. He then married Zelda Weedon on April 11, 1992 in Wichita, Kansas, and she survives him. Other survivors include his daughter, Carol J. Cook of Morrilton, and son, Michael T. Curtin of Topeka, Kansas; five grandchildren, four great-grandchildren, two step-children, and many step-grand and great-grandchildren.
