William Harold Reynolds, 91, of Conway, passed away Monday, January 7th, 2019. He was born April 16th, 1927 in Hattieville, Arkansas, a son of farmers the late Marvin and Essie Boyd Reynolds. He was a member of the University Church of Christ.

A World War II Veteran that spent over 22 years in the Army as a Staff Sergeant, serving in the 796 Police Battalion in Vienna, Austria and Korean Conflict as well as in support of the Vietnam War. Awarded: The Good Conduct Medal, Korean Service Medal with 2 Bronze Stars, The United Nations Service Medal and National Defense Service Medal. He and his wife of 35 years, Jane Cook Reynolds, were avid RVers, belonging to clubs and traveling the country and occasionally abroad. They owned and worked the B andn J Grocery in Old Hickory and enjoyed living there before owning and operating Walnut Grove RV Park in Kansas City then settling in Conway, Arkansas.
