Wilma Grace Moore Spradley, age 87, of Morrilton, Arkansas, passed away Wednesday, April 9, 2008. She was born May 6, 1920, in Solgohachia, Arkansas, a daughter of Gertrude Brice Moore and George W. Moore. She was a faithful follower of God's word and member of the Downtown Church of Christ in Morrilton.

She was preceded in death by her son Jay Spradley, age 18 and her husband, J.W. Spradley, age 42. Both passed away in Trenton, New Jersey. Also preceding her in death were her parents, three sisters and two brothers. Survivors include two sisters and one brother in-law; Gwyn Moore Mitchell and Jim Mitchell of Las Vegas, Nevada and Guy'lene Dwyer of Norman, Oklahoma; nephews and nieces, and a host of friends here, and in many other areas where she had resided.

She was a poet and song writer, quilt maker, and an avid reader. She was Supervisor of Oberman Company in Arkansas, Manager of the Dunlee Corporation in Trenton, New Jersey, Assistant Office Manager for General Electric Credit in Arkansas, Supervisor for the 1980 Census in Memphis, Tennessee. She was appointed Conway County's Veterans Service Officer in 1983.

She was on the State Board of Veterans Affairs, elected Vice President of Arkansas Department of Veterans Affairs State Association.

Since retirement on January 31, 1996, she has spent many years of volunteer work for veterans and their dependents and many other issues. Her help to

others was a constant in her life and she never wanted praise, honor, or credit for her deeds. She laid up her treasures in heaven "where moth nor rust doth not corrupt nor thieves break through and steal."

She will be sadly missed by loved ones and friends.

Graveside services will be 3:30 p.m. Saturday, April 12, 2008, at Elmwood Cemetery with Mr. Randy Rankin officiating. The family will receive friends from 7-9 p.m. Friday, April 11, at the funeral home in Morrilton.
